

90 DAYS REPORT

All foreigners staying in Thailand for more than 90 days must report their current address to Immigration every 90 days. This is required even if your visa is still valid and your address hasn't changed.

If you leave Thailand and return, the 90-day count starts over from your re-entry date.

So Every time you return to Thailand, you must inform your HR officer immediately.

Failure to inform HR may cause you to miss your 90-day reporting deadline.

If you fail to report on time, you will be fined 2,000 THB.

When to Report:

- You can report: 15 days before or up to 7 days after your due date.

How to Report: You have 2 options

1. Go in person to NST Immigration Office.
2. Submit your passport to HR, and they will report on your behalf.
